 - (iii) to raise and distribute funds to advance education by providing scholarships for individuals; and,
 - (iv) to take all other appropriate actions in furtherance of such purposes; to perform other activities permitted under Section 501(c)(3); and, consistent with the above, to exercise all powers available to corporations organized pursuant to the District of Columbia Nonprofit Corporation Act.
